## Notice for SECOND PHASE of Admission to B.A./B.Sc./B.Com Part-I Honours & General Courses for Academic Session 2017-2018

Fresh applications are invited for the second phase of admissions to the following subjects which have a few vacant seats left. The eligibility criteria for admission to B.A./B.Sc./B.Com Part-I Honours & General courses are listed below. To apply online the candidate has to visit the college website <http://gurudascallege.edu.in>. Only those who satisfy the eligibility criteria and have qualified in Higher Secondary or equivalent Examination from 2012 to 2017 (last five years) may apply. Candidates whose names appear in the first phase merit list but were not called for counseling may apply again. The technical Help Line 9830168755 may be contacted from 10 AM to 6 PM.

- Submission dates of online forms for all courses: 03/07/2017 [Monday, 10 AM] to 10/07/2017 [Monday, 5 PM]
- Application fee of Rs.100/- (Rupees one hundred only) can be submitted online (by means of net banking / debit card / credit card) to ICICI Bank or offline by printing and filling up an e-challan to any branch of ICICI Bank along with a bank charge of Rs.15/- (Rupees fifteen only). Application fee will be accepted upto 10/07/2017 (5pm).
- Merit list will be published on 12<sup>th</sup> July, 2017 in the College website. Date and time of counseling and admission will be mentioned in the College website.
- Admission ends on 21/07/2017.

### Eligibility criteria for receiving forms for General courses:

- (1) B.A. (General): NO VACANCY
- (2) For B.Sc. (General) Physical Science & Biological Science – Pass in the previous Examination, General subjects as per Calcutta University norms.
- (3) For B.Com General - 40% in aggregate (best four) and 40% marks in Accountancy / Business Studies / Business Economics including Business Mathematics / Mathematics / Economics/ Commerce.

❖ For SC/ST candidates: 40% in the subject or 40% in the aggregate.

❖ Reservation of Seats: 22% for SC, 6% for ST & OBC ("A"10% and "B"7%), DA (3%) (According to existing Government rules).

❖ For admission in any stream **pass in English** is necessary; pass in lab-based subject means pass in both theory and practical.

### The following documents have to be attached along with downloaded application form at the time of counselling:

- i) Self-attested copies of marksheet and admit card of H.S. or its equivalent exam.
- ii) Copy of the evidence of Date of Birth
- iii) Copy of the SC/ST/OBC (Gr. A or B)/DA certificate (if required)

- iv) Printed receipt of online payment OR printed e-challan after offline payment at the authorised bank.
- v) Two passport size photographs (at the time of Admission)
- vi) Transfer Certificate (if required)
