• Library As an Extension Centre

As the College is a study centreofNetajiSubhas Open University's (NSOU) distance learning, it allows the students of different courses conducted by the NSOUto access library service (except for home issue) so that they can get the actual benefit of education. In this regard, the School of Professional Studies of NSOU has acknowledged the College for its active support and formally requested the Principal of the College to allow its library facilities to the learners admitted in different courses conducted by the Department of Library and Information Science, NSOU on Sundays (copy enclosed). Besides, in an agreement, the College has been mutually agreed with Bengal Library Association to allow their students of 'Certificate in Library Science' for availing library facilities within working hours (copy enclosed). Again, teachers of Shyamaprasad Mukherjee Institution (a Higher Secondary School under West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education, Government of West Bengal) quite often avail library service for better presentation of lectures in the class. Not only that, former faculty members of the College are allowed to avail library facilities for their learning as well as their creation in academic world. Moreover, Gurudas College Library regularly organizes 'Library Day Programme' where different intelligentsia share their opinion on various aspects of books, library and reading. Besides, College Library regularly organizes 'Annual Book Fair and Little Magazine Fair'. In both theseprogrammes, persons from different corners of the society are allowed to participate and share their views.
