Forewords

Photography plays a very significant role in all spheres of life. Owing to abundance of Mobile & Digital cameras, everyone whether young or old can now take snaps. A backdated (2016) Statistical record indicate that about 38 crores of photos are uploaded in a day which is equivalent to 4400 snaps per second. But techniques of photography still remain a mystery to a large section of the society and many people shoot without knowing the ABC of Photography.

The Photographic Association of Dum Dum (PAD) is a voluntary organization, affiliated to Federation of Indian Photography, National body for Photography in India, and an indirect member of the Fédération Internationale de l'Art Photographique (FIAP), a UNESCO recognised body. PAD is serving globally for the cause of photographic development since its inception in 1957. Its motto is to promote and propagate Photography through different ways in various capacities via Annual International Salons, International conferences, organising photographic Courses, Participating in Salons, Students' & Members' Exhibitions, routine excursions and sharing each other's experience in transforming picture into Art. PAD is providing teaching support to many organisations to foster photographic education in India and this time to Gurudas College.

The Gurudas College in collaboration with Photographic Association of Dum Dum, has introduced a 4 months Certificate Courses for the students of Gurudas College titled "Certificate course on "Basics of Photography". This course is for about 32 hours duration (2 periods of 1 hour per week for four months). The course is designed to help the students to understand the ABC of Photography. Basic concepts of various theoretical aspects and hand on training (Practical demonstrations and outdoor classes) will be dwelt upon so as to enable them to equip themselves to practice the subjects and to do work independently at any concern.

At present this is a course mainly for the students of Journalism & Mass Communication Department of Gurudas College where the students get an opportunity to establish a connection with the different experts of Photographic Association of Dum Dum working in various fields, and pursue relevant study in near future.

Earlier PAD has conducted such a course for the students of RamaKrishana Sarada Mission Vivekananda Vidyabhabhan extending for a period of one year (1 hour per week). In the month of July PAD will conduct a Summer course on Photography for the 2nd Semester Postgraduate students of the Kalyani University and also provide teaching support to the Photographic Society of Murshidabad for their certificate course which will start on 14th July, 2019.

We take this opportunity to extend our sincere gratitude and heartfelt thanks to the authorities of Gurudas College particularly to Dr. Mausumi Chatterjee, Principal for inviting us to conduct the course and Dr. Joydeep Chandra, Librarian and acting head of the Journalism & Mass communication Department for his active cooperation. We also extend our sincere thanks to those who obliged us by their blessing messages.

It is expected that the Students of Gurudas College will be immensely benefitted in particular and Photography will flourish in general. Before I conclude, let us hope that Photography will go a long way to cultivate knowledge as a means of livelihood and as a medium of creative expression. It will foster international brotherhood as the universal language of photography is understood by one and all.
