

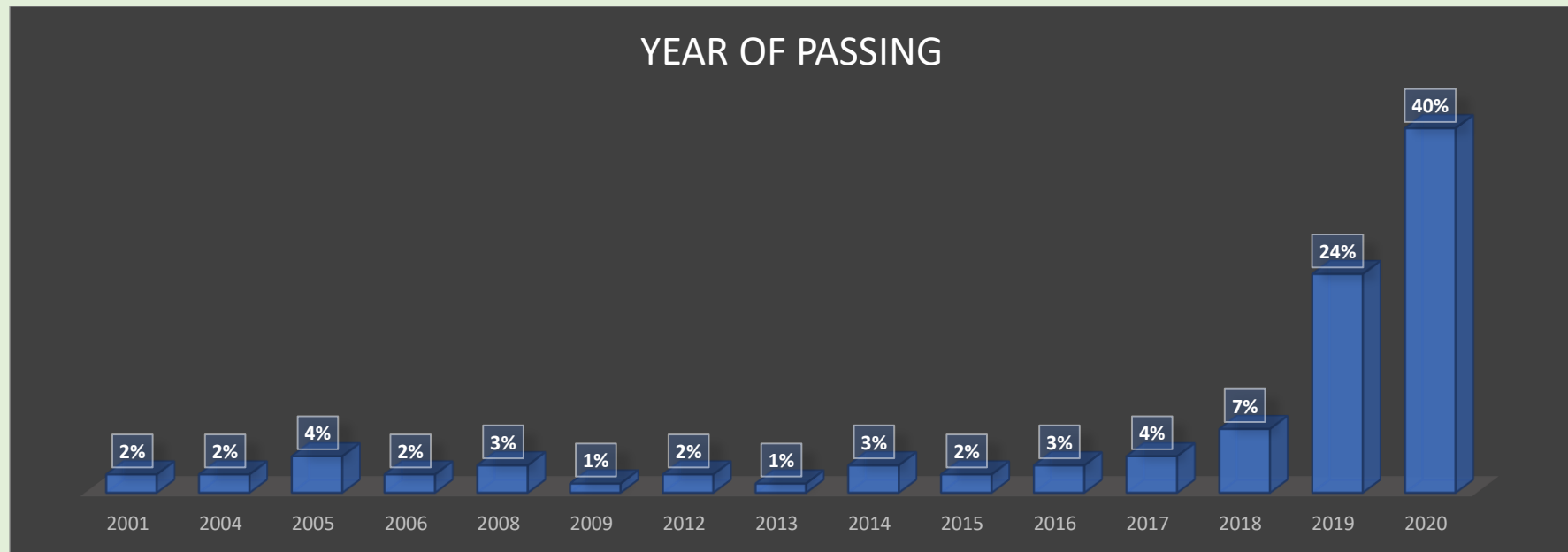


Alumni Feedback Analysis (2019-20)

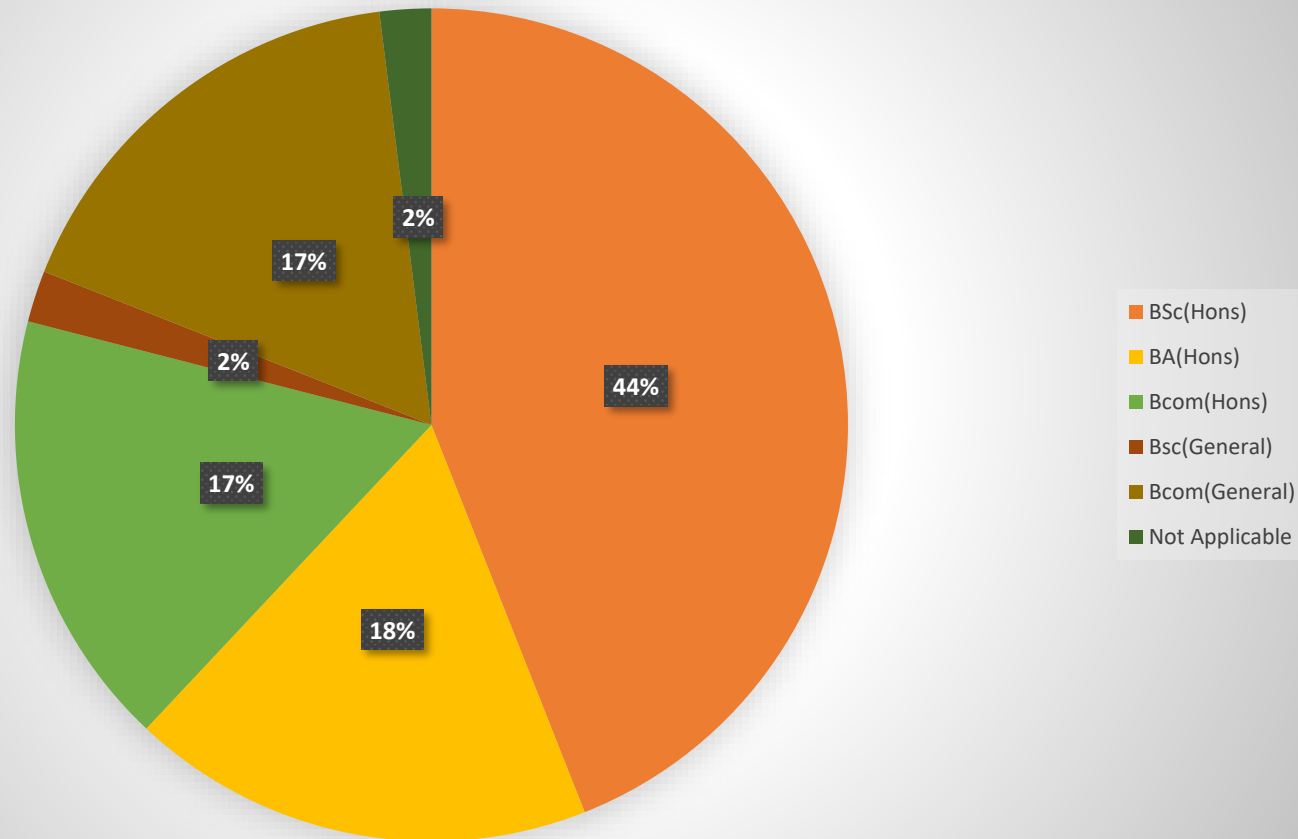

Year of Passing

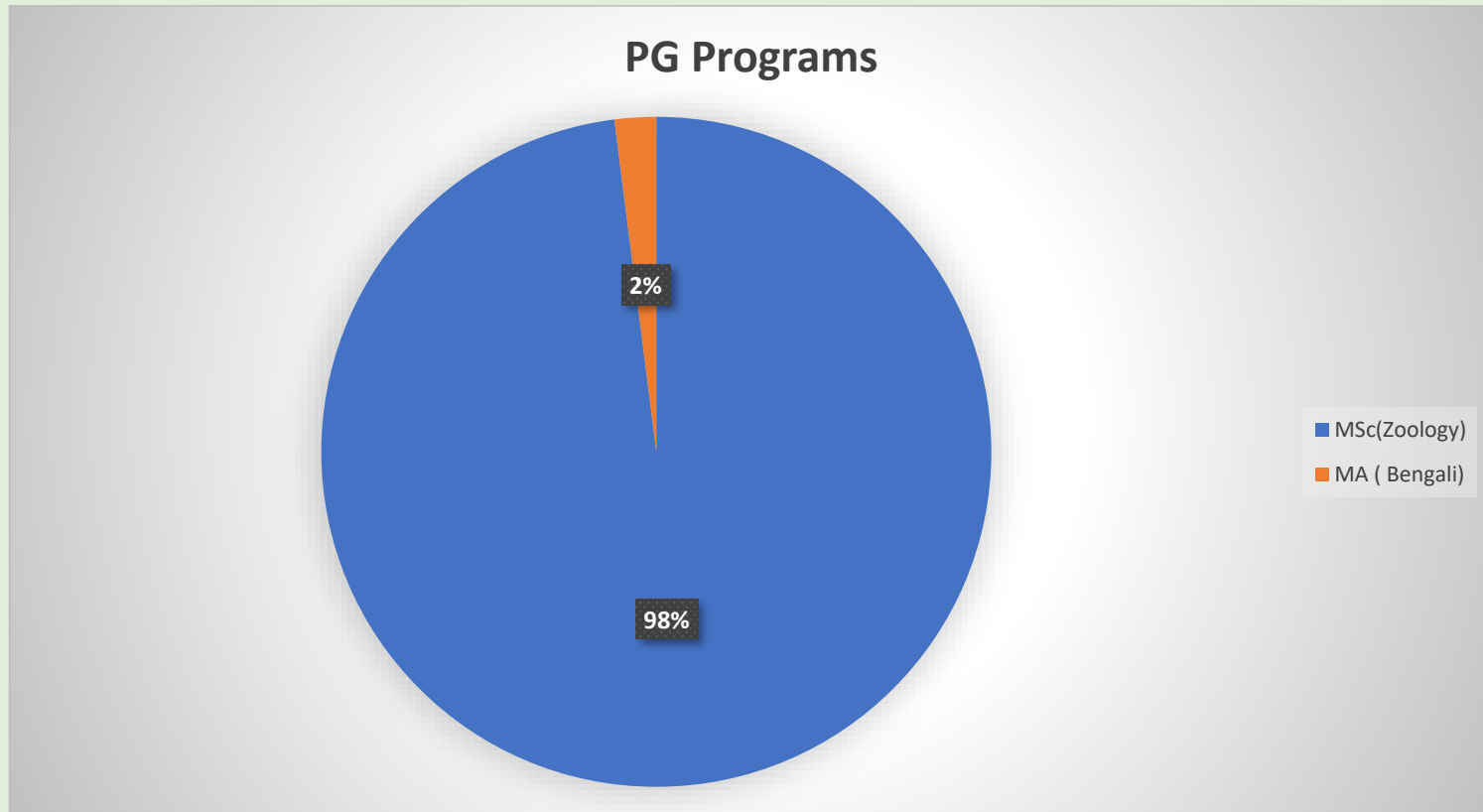

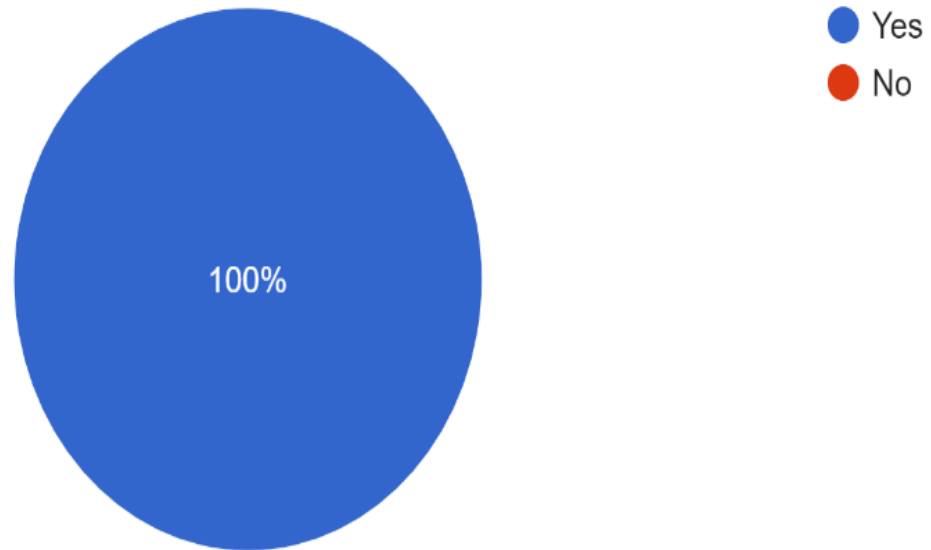

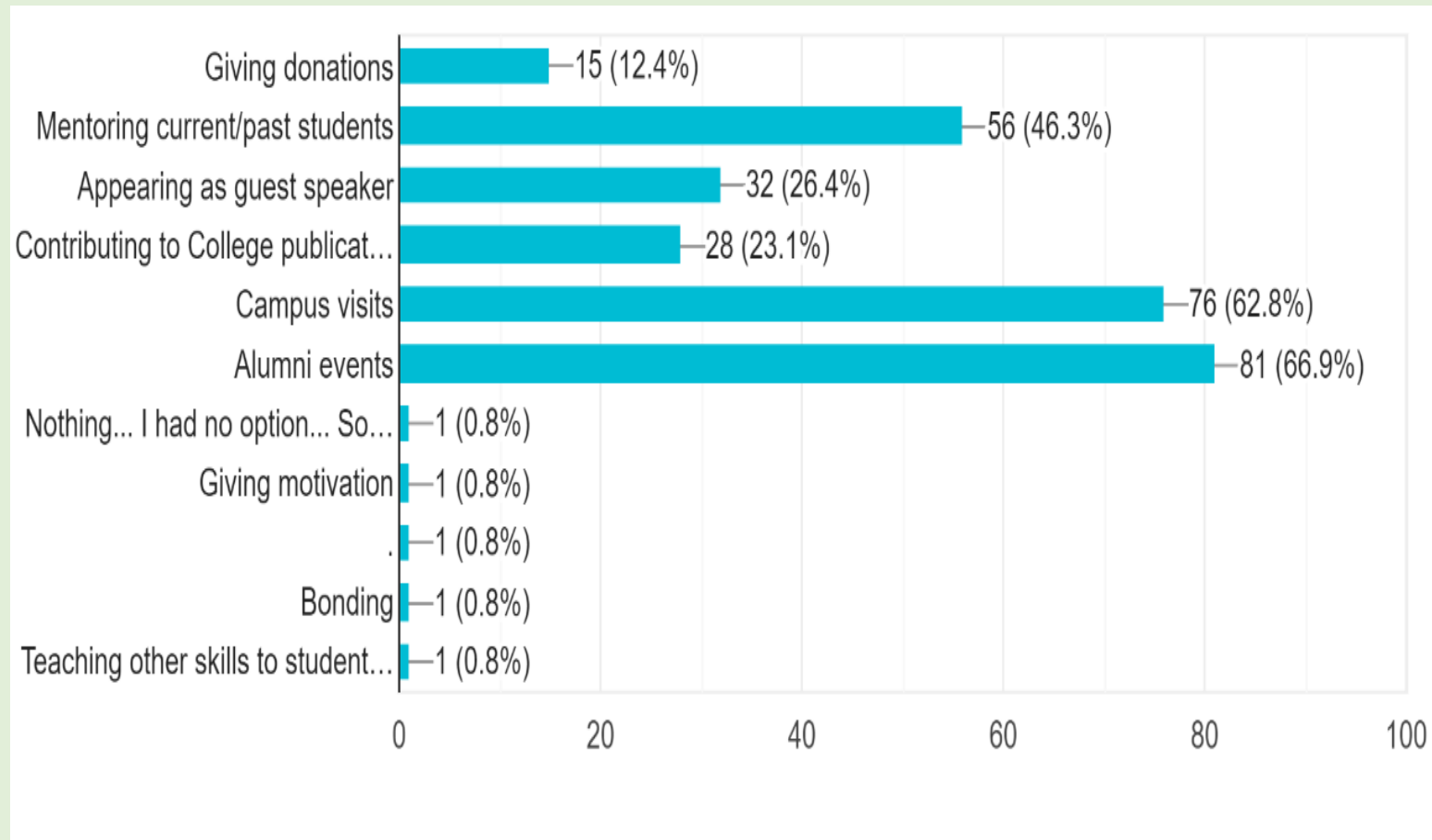
Programs (PG)



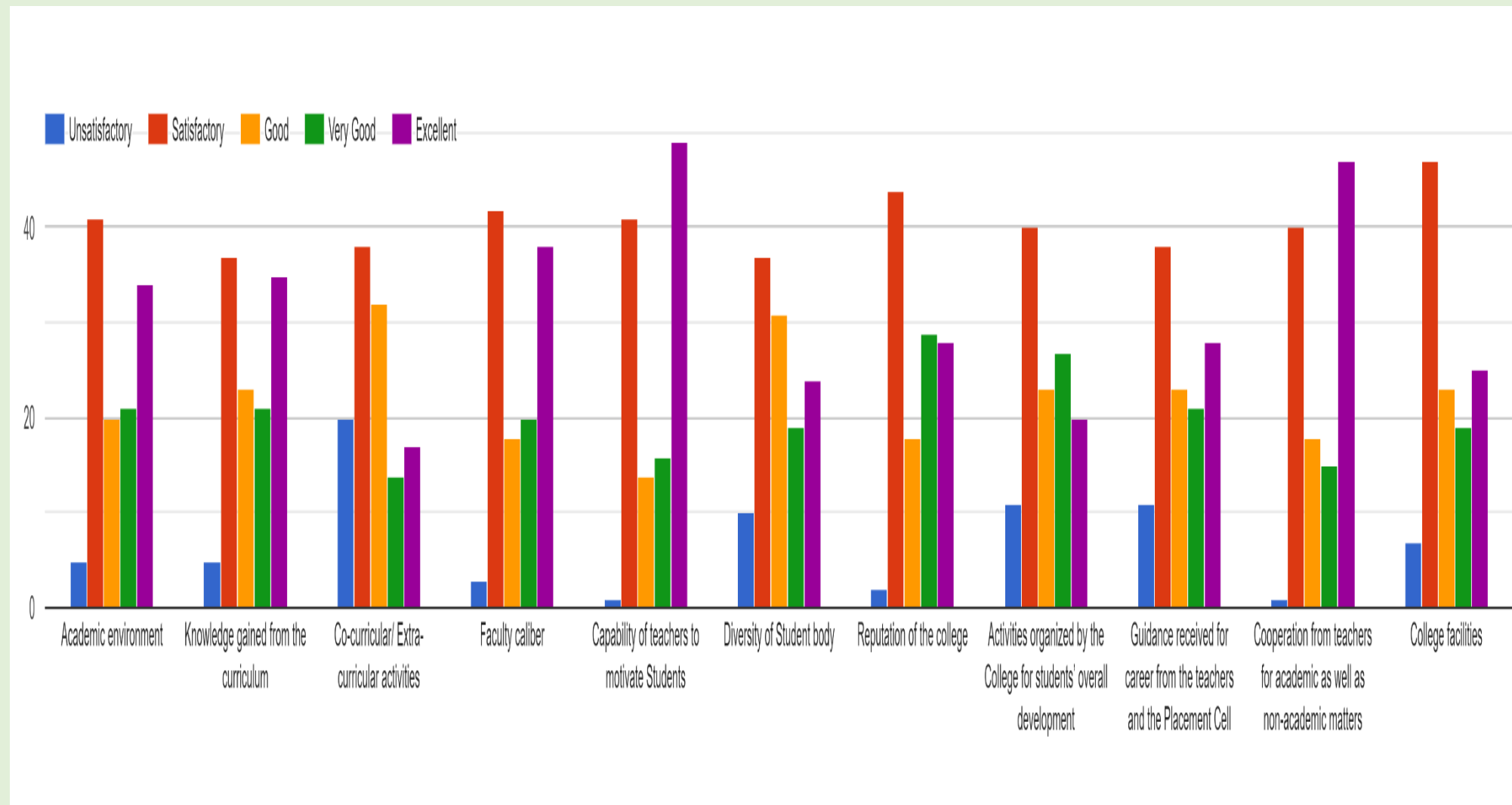
Do you feel proud to be an alumnus of Gurudas College?

The responses show that most of the alumni are satisfied with college infrastructure, teaching-learning, teaching quality etc. However, students have pointed out some weaknesses along with strengths of the college which are listed below.

Strengths:

- Diverse, dynamic as well as experienced faculty members
- Amicable student-teacher relationship
- Motivating teaching staff
- Highly qualified teachers

Weaknesses:

- Canteen facilities need to be improved
- Official work for the students' needs to be less time consuming
- Students expect more cooperation from the office staff.
- The number of classrooms is not adequate.



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Action taken Report: Alumni Feedback

The responses from the alumni indicate that most of them are satisfied with the college infrastructure, teaching-learning, teaching quality, calibre of faculties etc. However, alumni have pointed out some weaknesses of the college. The college authority has noted those and is taking appropriate steps to address the weaknesses. The weaknesses pointed are as follows.

Weaknesses:

- Canteen facilities need to be improved
- Official work for the students' needs to be less time consuming
- Students expect more cooperation from the office staff.
- Classrooms are not adequate.

Action Taken:

- Steps have been taken to improve canteen facilities
- To reduce waiting time, many official works are being done online mode.
- New construction adjacent to the main building is taking place so that the issues of room shortages can be resolved.

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
