


Guardians' Feedback Analysis (2020-21)

The views and experience of guardians regarding our college are invaluable as they may reveal the scope for improvement in various dimensions of the college. Pursuing such an initiative the college conducted a survey online and collected feedback from 346 guardians. This was done to understand and analyze their views on infrastructure, teaching quality, quality of the library, and the basic facilities regarding other amenities of the college. A brief analysis of those responses is given below



College Environment Conducive for overall development




Note: The responses are recorded on a 5-point scale, where 5 is considered as excellent and 1 is considered as poor.

Exposure to career orientation




Note: The responses are recorded on a 5-point scale, where 5 is considered as excellent and 1 is considered as poor.

Note: The responses are recorded on a 5-point scale, where 5 is considered as excellent and 1 is considered as poor.


Authority Approachable regarding any queries



Note: The responses are recorded on a 5-point scale, where 5 is considered as excellent and 1 is considered as poor.


From the above self-explanatory graphs, one can infer that the Guardians seem to be satisfied with the college facilities, environment and ambience and also find the college authority to be easily approachable.

Program wise Guardians' Feedback




The major part of the guardians' feedback came from BSc Honours. Around 67% of respondents said their ward studied BSc Honours while 17.5% of respondents said that their wards are enrolled in BA Honours programme. 9.4 % of the feedback came from the guardian whose ward was in MSc.

Teaching Learning Facility




Guardians seem to be pleased with the teaching-learning facilities provided by this college as 42% of respondents said facilities are excellent and 52.9% of respondents said facilities are good.

Library Facility




Gurudas College library provides facilities that may not be available to the libraries of other colleges. It is a member of the UGC Nlist Consortium and the National Digital Library of India. It is also an institutional member of the British Council Kolkata. It has undertaken the open-source initiative through the library: Koha, Wikimedia, Omeka, Moodle and VUFIND. Faculty members encourage students to make use of a large number of online journals, databases and other e-resources available herein. Hence our survey findings show that Guardians are more than satisfied with the library facilities provided to their wards. 35.7% of the Guardians say the library facility is excellent and 55.6% of the respondents say the facility is good.

Sports and Cultural Activities



Nearly 70% of total respondents think that the sports and cultural activities are good or excellent; however, 24.3% of respondents feel that these activities are average.


Students' Counselling Activities



Students' counselling is of extreme importance to the wards. Since on one hand, it guides the students in choosing an appropriate career and helps in promoting the students' overall


emotional well-being, on the other. It appears from the feedback that Guardians are more than satisfied with the support provided by the college in this regard.

Remedial Classes




In a class there are students of different aptitudes; some find it easy to grasp the college lectures while others need a little more attention. The college has a mechanism of identifying the slow learners and provide them with remedial classes so that no outside help is required to clear the exams. Guardians also share our view that remedial classes are quite effective for their wards.

Direct Communication with teaching staff



The college has a mechanism to hold Parent Teacher Meetings at regular intervals so that guardians and the faculty members can have direct communication regarding the performance of students, their attendance in class, or any other issue. The college has made arrangements for online parent-teacher meetings during the time of this unprecedented pandemic. Guardians seem to be happy with this platform as 92.1% of the respondents have said that they availed this platform to communicate directly with the teaching staff.

Satisfaction with the Online Teaching



Around 80% of the guardian respondents say that their wards are satisfied with the online teaching that is taking place during this ongoing pandemic period.

Though most of the guardians are satisfied with the facilities provided by the college there were suggestions by some which leaves us with room for improvement.

Conclusion:

Feedback from guardians is encouraging for us as it makes us feel that we are on the right track. But we are not complacent and have noted the suggestions provided by them.
