On 13th May , 2022, a seminar was organized in Gurudas College , Phoolbagan for the better half of the students of Computer Science students taking them into an adventurous ride on a roller coaster, letting them know about the importance of **Internet of Things and the artificial knowledge and intelligence**. The illuminating event was held in the Rajendralal Mitra Sabhagriha room. The event was commenced by our Respected Head Of the Department , Professor Sreejita Gupta giving a warm welcome to Respected Dr. Tuhin Utsab Paul (M.Tech, M.Sc) , who is an Assistant Professor from St. Xaviers University ,along with our other Respected Professors Kajari Bhattachatrjee and Sonali Gupta in coordination with all the 3 year's Computer Science Department.


The program took off at about 11 a.m. in the morning and had a colorful wrap up at almost around 2 p.m. in the afternoon. He spoke us on one of the most sought after topics , 'The Internet of Things (IoT)'. He first gave us a short preview on the topic with real life examples. He told us that lot is a practical application of Webconnectivity for data transmission irrespective of any kind of device over a wide range of area without human interaction. The basic principle of IoT is that it basically works independently without any human interaction. It serves from devices to Server and vice versa in real life to work easily with very less effort. Some basic building blocks include Sensors, Actuator, RFID Tags, Cloud Based Application Storage and especially Data Mining. He also spoke about the different layers of IoT , with a grand information about his exemplar with his students on Building a Navigation System for a Blind Person under the label of 'Vision X ' and giving us the advantages and disadvantages of his research he radiantly wrapped up the whole seminar , adding a feather in each and every student's hat.

To the feat of the seminar, there was also a questionnaire round for the students to clarify their doubts regarding the same. Everyone seemed to be gladiantly radiating by absorbing the informative knowledge that we had gained during the seminar making it a very successful one. Lastly, the winners of the previously held seminars were felicitated with awards and certificates, following up with a vote of thanks and token of gratitude from our Departmental Professors to Resepected Dr. Tuhin Utsab Paul in the same regards.

(Dept. of Economics)

Extension Lecture-1

An extension lecture on "Rational Expectation & Economic Growth: A General Discussion on Macroeconomics" was held on 15th March, 2022 organized by Dept. of Economics in collaboration with IQAC, Research cell, Seminar committee of Gurudas College. The lecture delivered by Prof. Kausik Gupta, University of Calcutta.

No of students attended: 36

Summary:

The seminar was based on Macroeconomics and it covered few important portion of our syllabus, such as an overview of consumer behaviour, rational expectation and economic growth. Basic elements of New Keynesian Macroeconomics (NKM) along with a brief comparison of traditional Keynesian Models and NKM, efficiency wage theory was discussed.

Apart from these, under exogenous growth theory, it covered The Harrod Model, The Domar model and under endogenous growth theory it covered The AK Model, endogenous growth with transitional dynamics, an overview of Romar Model, Barros' Model. This process was beneficial for the faculties too.







Extension Lecture II

The Department of Economics organized an Invited webinar on 29th March, 2022. Prof. Alex M. Thomas from Azim Premji University, Bangalore delivered a talk on 'Understanding the Indian Economy through Fiction.' Prof. Thomas took a very unconventional approach to teach some of the crucial economics concepts. He showed how various Indian Novels can be used to understand the concept called Interlinked Market, Preferences, Land, Labour Mobility, Remittances etc in the Indian context. The webinar helped the students to understand the complex ideas in a very lucid manner. The students also got a window to think and understand the world outside their classrooms through the lenses of economics. Prof. Thomas also discussed the critical pedagogy of teaching Economics. He mainly talked about how one teacher can engage the students and how a critical perspective can be developed inside an Economics Classroom. This process was beneficial for the faculties too. The webinar ignited questions and comments from the viewers. This lecture was live-streamed on YouTube, and it received 381 views.
