Reasons for Mapping:

1. The Feminist Approach to Political Science in the paper Understanding Political Theory: Approaches and Debates helps student to understand the problem facing women like gender discrimination, sexual violence and lack of participation of women in political affairs.
2. Women's movements in India in the paper Politics in India: Structures and Processes give a broad understanding of the struggle of Indian women for empowerment.
