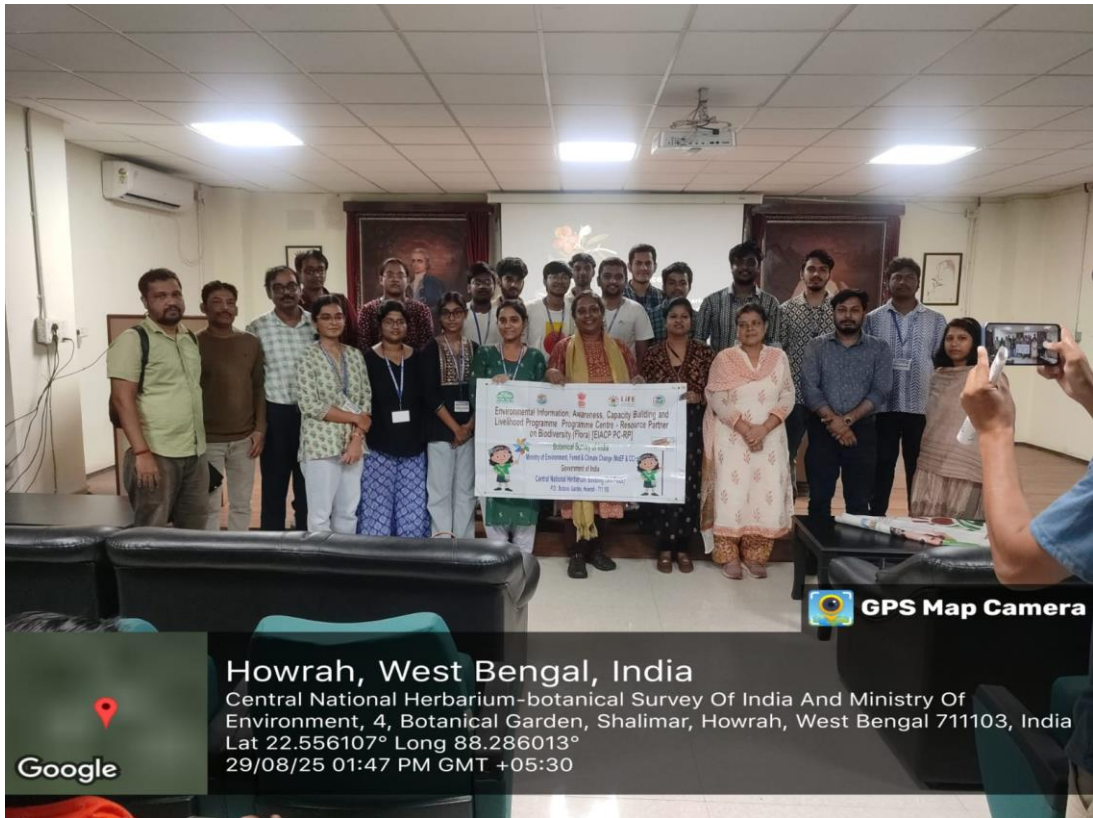

The Department of Botany organized yet another experiential learning trip to the **Acharya Jagadish Chandra Bose Indian Botanic Garden** on **August 29st, 2025**. The students from **Semester II (Major, Minor, MD) CCF along with Semester II Biochemistry and Semester IV Zoology** accompanied by Dr. Ripan Chandra Das, Dr. Mousumi Das, Dr. Goutam Kumar Pahari, Dr. Mitu De and Dr. Moumita Bishai visited the garden, located in Shibpur, near Howrah, Kolkata. The garden, a National Heritage site, spans along the River Hoogly and showcases an extensive collection of native and exotic floras, including rare and endangered species. Under the guidance of their faculty, students explored the garden's diverse plant species. One of our alumni student Mr. Rohon Maity, Employee of CNH was also present on that day to guide the students during the tour. The visit also included a trip to the Charakha Uddyan, where students observed the arrangement of plants according to ancient Vedic principles. Additionally, they visited the Central National Herbarium to gain insight into the technical aspects of herbarium preparation and procedures. During the trip, students interacted with experts and officials from the Botanic Garden, gaining valuable knowledge and wisdom.
